We would like to thank you for supplying Garden Vines with the crates needed to create the raised garden beds for the three Hempstead Elementary schools involved in S.E.E.D.S. Your donation was pivotal in getting this program started.

We are now successfully growing produce in these school gardens that will serve 800 or so students and their families. At the elementary level, 84 percent of the students rely on free or reduced school lunch. Our hope is to grow and harvest such a surplus of food that it puts a dent in childhood hunger and improves food security among the students and families involved – as well as in the larger community, through our forthcoming community gardens.

By supplementing the food intake of these children, we help to nourish their minds and bodies.
